Dear Sir or Madam,

Cellofoam International GmbH hereby confirms, on the basis of the information currently available to it from suppliers and upstream suppliers, that the sound and thermal insulation products it manufactures comply with the requirements of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH).

In particular, to the best of our current knowledge, our products do not contain any substances subject to authorisation under Annex XIV of the REACH Regulation. Furthermore, the applicable restrictions and requirements of Annex XVII of the REACH Regulation are complied with. The products are therefore, in principle, compliant with the requirements of the REACH Regulation.

Under Article 33 of REACH, suppliers are obliged to inform their customers of the presence of substances of very high concern (SVHCs) in articles, provided that their concentration exceeds 0.1% by weight (w/w). This obligation to provide information applies regardless of whether the article in question meets the other requirements of the REACH Regulation.

For the following product groups:

- Articles with the designation **PE-20**
- Articles with the designation **PE**
- Articles with the designation **D2500**
- **NBR** tubes and articles with a thickness of > 6 mm

we hereby declare, in accordance with Article 33 of REACH, that these products contain the substance

Decabromodiphenylethane (DBDPE)

1,1'-(Ethane-1,2-diyl)to[pentabrombenzol]

CAS-Nr. 84852-53-9

in a concentration of more than 0.1% by weight (w/w).

This notification is provided solely to fulfil the statutory information requirements under Article 33 of REACH, due to the presence of a substance on the SVHC Candidate List in quantities exceeding the statutory threshold. The substance information in question does not affect the overall REACH compliance of the products mentioned.

This statement is based on the information provided by our suppliers at the time of issue, as well as the current status of the REACH Candidate List. It has been drawn up to the best of our knowledge and will be updated accordingly should new regulatory or product-related findings come to light. Cellofoam has not carried out any analyses or tests of its own to verify the presence of the substances mentioned.
